Groveland Summer Recreation Program:

- Director, Matt Castonguay, and On-Site Director, Madison Lesiczka, presented updates for the summer recreation program:

 - The program invested roughly \$12,000 for a large locked storage container on school grounds to store their items (slides, large inflatables, activity equipment, etc.)
 - Concerns regarding upcoming years and utilizing the school space without disturbance to day-to-day program activites

- Dog park expected to open late December
- Currently looking into options for testing the irrigation well

Elm Square:

- Holiday lights to be set up along the trees and gazebo for the holiday season

Trail Maintenance:

- The committee discussed cleanups for the trails and potential opportunities for assistance from the community to keep them consistently maintained. The Committee plans to touch more on this during the next meeting after the holidays
