Rules and Regulations for Town of Groveland Conservation Areas

You may:

- 1. Hike, ski, and snowshoe on trails prepared for these activities.
- 2. Observe a variety of songbirds, birds of prey, and other wildlife.
- 3. Discover unusual wetlands, meadows, and plant species.
- 4. Picnic on a carry-in, carry-out basis.
- 5. Use radios with earphones only.
- 6. Walk dogs on a leash only and clean up and remove all waste.
- 7. Camp overnight with special permission from the Conservation Commission.
- 8. Have group picnics or cookouts with special permission from the Conservation Commission.
- 9. Ride horses with permission from the Conservation Commission and under dry land conditions only.

You may NOT:

- 1. Litter.
- 2. Deface or vandalize.
- 3. Hunt or trap unless posted as allowed.
- 4. Remove plants or wildlife.
- 5. Cut firewood.
- 6. Swim.
- 7. Drive or ride motorized vehicles, including automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, dirt bikes, snowmobiles, all terrain vehicles (ATV's) or any other vehicles driven by motors except on paved roads.
- 8. Play paintball games.
- 9. Have campfires.
- 10. Possess alcoholic beverages except when permitted by the Board of Selectmen.
- 11. Play amplified sound without permission from the Conservation Commission.
