Meeting Minutes

September 7, 2021

Present: Dower, Kastrinelis, and Superintendent Desrociers.

Called to order at 1002 hours.

Superintendent Report:

1. Deere Mower. Replacement tires and cutting blades are installed on the mower.

Future Items:

- 1. Billis Way Fencing. Due to the continued instability along the steep section of Lot#3, fencing is not advisable in this area. The rear section of the lot line will require removal of our unused urn line and approximately six open double plots to accommodate the proposed fencing in this area. Motion by Kastrinelis to remove the six plots and urn line and having the Superintendent re-engineer the undeveloped rear area of Section 200. thus adding up to sixteen double plots back to the inventory (net double lot gain of 12). Second - Dower. Favorable - Unanimous.
- 2. Granite Pillars. It appears the pillars along the lot line at the front of the cemetery were moved to the current location within the last 15 years. They do not have any historical value based on this information relative to their placement. The Chair will enter discussions with the property owner concerning the removal of the pillars and the proposed placement and installation of the new black fencing in the area.
- 3. Loam/ Level Lot #3 line. Motion by Dower to request East Coast Excavating assist the Superintendent in adding loam to level this area for the proposed new fencing installation. Second - Kastrinelis. Favorable -Unanimous.

Hearse House.

1. The historical impact of removing this unstable structure is under review. The Chair will meet with the Historical Committee to discuss demolishing the building and constructing an appropriate replacement structure.

Smallpox Cemetery.

1. Some of the damaged cast iron pipe fencing needs to be replaced. Motion by Dower to have the Superintendent purchase replacement piping to make the needed repairs. Second – Kastrinelis. Favorable – Unanimous. Meeting adjourned at 1130 hours.
