CALLED TO ORDER: at 16:35 by Chairperson Stewart

A motion by D. Stewart and 2nd by R. Dower to accept the minutes of April 17, 2018 was made. The vote unanimous; 3-0

- 2. R. Dower reported that Bob Polizzoti had the water turned on at the Cemetery and that he had repaired 3 or 4 leaks.
- 3. A motion by M. Kastrinelis and 2^{nd} by D. Stewart to have the Finance Director post the part-time for help. Vote unanimous 3-0
- 4. A motion by M. Kastrinelis and 2nd by D. Stewart to have the Finance Director use the CPA funds from the Document Management Account to purchase a computer, monitor, printer/copier, and external hard drive, and any other associated software for the system.
- 5. Front entrance: Check the landscape architect's layout for the placing of trees at the front. M. Kastrinelis will contact Northeast Nursery about pricing. A motion by M.Kastrinelis and 2nd by D. Stewart to install 4 Elm trees of the disease resistant type. Vote unanimous, 3-0. A discussion was held on signage for the front entrance. A 4' by 8' map of the Cemetery would be helpful to the public. R. Dower will check with the Sign Center in Haverhill. A motion by M. Kastrinelis and 2nd by D. Stewart to get a CAD image on vinyl not to exceed \$3000.00 for the office was made. Vote was unanimous. 3-0.
- 6. Restoration of old burial grounds: This will be a 3 phase project; 1st RFP for the project; 2nd Review of the project; 3rd Award bid. This part of the project will take care of about 1/3 of the old burial grounds. The Finance Director will need the scope of the work to be performed, to be able to go out for an RFP.

April 27, 2018

A motion by D. Stewart and 2nd by M. Kastrinelis to start the process to restore the old burial grounds, Vote unanimous 3-0. Robert Guptil offered to put the specifications together so the Finance Director can put the RFP out for the project

- 7. Deeds- M. Kastrinelis will print up the deed for an owner who purchased a lot last week, and have it ready to be signed.
- 8. Town Meeting will be voting on the funding for engineering for the new section of Cemetery property. A correct and accurate map of the Cemetery has to be ready for this.
- 9. A discussion was held about the job description M. Kastrinelis had put together using the various job descriptions given to the Commissioners.
- 10. R. Dower reported that Methuen Memorials contacted him in regard to the damage on a particular headstone. A motion by R. Dower and 2nd by M. Kastrinelis to have Methuen Memorials repair the headstone, the cost not to exceed \$1,350.00. Vote was unanimous 3-0. It was discussed that True Green should continue with the work they did last year. A plan to develop Pine Ave. in the future was discussed. R. Dower is checking on the mowers to be repaired. M.B. Tractor, Plaistow have ordered the parts to repair the X-Mark mower. Headstone repair will continue depending on funding. Discussion on the Perpetual Care and the Sale of Lots accounts as to which account can be used for what purposes.
