Leah Bates received sponsorship checks from Baldini Plumbing and Heating (Corporate Sponsor) and Daniels Electric (Associate Sponsor) and gave the checks to treasurer, Jill Krisiak.

Other businesses have been contacted about sponsorships and donations and we are waiting to hear back from them.

Leah Bates confirmed that Curious Creatures is booked for the event and they will come at 11:00am.

Discussed the basketball tournament in more detail and the plan to use "Signup Genius" for team sign-ups.

Discussed the need for music or a DJ for the event.

Lisa Chandler confirmed that the Groveland police department has the event booked for September 7th. The Groveland Day Committee will need police detail for an 8 hour block of time from 9 am - 5pm for the event that will run from 10-4pm. One police officer will set up an area for free car seat safety checks during the event with two other officers working the event.
