12 NEW: Application #2022-2, 18 King Street, Richard Cammett; under General Laws, Chapter 40A, as 13 amended, for the premises located at 18 King Street located in the Residential 2 (R2) Zoning District 14

special permit pursuant to MGL 40A Section 6, for a lot line adjustment.

15 Cammett: I've owned the property for a very long time, and my grandson owns 4 Garrison, and I

16 would like to give him some extra yard for his family and kids to use.

17 Yetman: We originally brought this to the Planning Board for an ANR approval, but were referred

18 back to the ZBA because it is a grandfathered preexisting nonconforming lot. The lot line change we

19 are proposing would actually relieve one of the nonconformities of 4 Garrison, as the house is

20 currently within the side setback. No existing nonconformities are made worse by this lot line change.

21 **BOARD:** Were there any public comments?

22 Schindler: No, there was one question, which was whether or not Mr. Cammett was building 23

something, but I explain it was for a lot line change. 24

MOTION: Brad Ligols motioned to accept the application and close the public hearing for

25 Application 2022-2, a special permit pursuant to MGL 40A Section 6 to perform a lot line change on 26

18 King Street and 4 Garrison Street. Jason Naves seconded the motion. The vote was 4-0, unanimous in favor.
