Nationwide, but especially in the Northeast, we are expecting significant rise in Covid-19 Omicron subvariant presence through this fall and winter. Presently, Essex County is at a **MODERATE LEVEL.** The metrics we follow are steadily rising as are **Influenza and RSV infections.**

NOW IS THE TIME TO TIGHTEN UP PRECAUTIONS. We all enjoyed a "normalized summer". But with the return of cool weather, indoor activities and groups of people proportionately increase exposure and infection risks. Hospitals are already seeing a surge.

 The Board of Health strongly encourages a common sense approach to prevention to control a surge. We support vaccination and boosters for Covid-19, flu shots, good sanitation and frequent hand washing and voluntary face masks where social distancing is not possible and in the presence of high risk individuals.
