 driver training with Frank Sapienti. Indeed, the town website, and other job listing organizations are posting
 the part-time van driver position, following the resignation of Ken Dusombre.
- Office changes are scheduled for June. COA will move into the current assessor's office. Maria will move
 into the current office of the Director (Amanda) and Program/Transportation (Nisha) which will have
 adequate space for COA office supplies and an expanded food pantry with more shelving and a fridge. This
 will allow for more food donations from Our Neighbors' Table. At this time, Veteran Service will be in
 Maria's office once a month on a day that she does not work.
