ARTICLE 4: To see if the Town will approve the \$10,000,000 borrowing authorized by vote of the Pentucket Regional School District, for the purpose of paying costs of making extraordinary repairs to the District's Page Elementary School located at 694 Main Street, West Newbury, Massachusetts, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto, which proposed repair project would materially extend the useful life of the school and preserve an asset that otherwise is capable of supporting the required educational program, said sum to be expended at the direction of the School Building Committee. The Massachusetts School Building Authority's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any costs of the Project that the District incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the District, and that the total amount of the borrowing authorized by this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Project Funding Agreement relating to the proposed repair project that may be executed between the District and the MSBA, or take any other action relative thereto. All costs of this project, including the debt service on the bonds or notes issued by the District to finance this project, shall be allocable solely to the Town of West Newbury.
