ROADWAY PAVING NOTICE

Dear Homeowner or Resident.

The Town of Groveland, MA and or/the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MaDOT) have scheduled your street (or the street that abuts your property) to be re-paved in the upcoming months. The work will be done by a contractor and may begin as early as **April 1, 2025**, but we will update the exact date as soon as we get a schedule from our contractor.

Please make note of following:

- Normal construction operations will take place between 7:00 am and 3:30 pm, Monday through
 Friday, except holidays. Construction hours may vary depending on the task ongoing. Traffic
 Control Police details will be onsite, and efforts will be made to keep the roadway open to all
 traffic.
- Due to the nature of the work, unmarked irrigation systems or buried invisible dog fences
 within the Town's right-of-way may become accidentally damaged. If you have either of each,
 close to the edge of the road, please mark the locations. The Town and its contractor are not
 responsible for irrigation systems or buried invisible dog fences in the Town's right-of-way
 but will make every effort to not damage them.
- If necessary, trash collection times may be altered, if this should occur residents will be notified.
- If your mailbox is set back from the roadway, it may be moved closer as specified by the US Postal Service Guidelines to safeguard the edge of the new road pavement from any future damage.
- Driveway aprons/openings may have to be cut and repaved to meet the level of the newly paved roadway.
- Once the roadway has been paved, a 5-year moratorium will be in effect, which means no utility work, except for emergencies, will be allowed on the roadway. Residents that would like to tie into any utility (i.e., water, sewer, gas, electric, cable) should do so before paving work is completed on their street.
